

Incorporating PPM Data Into Arbitron's National Radio Services

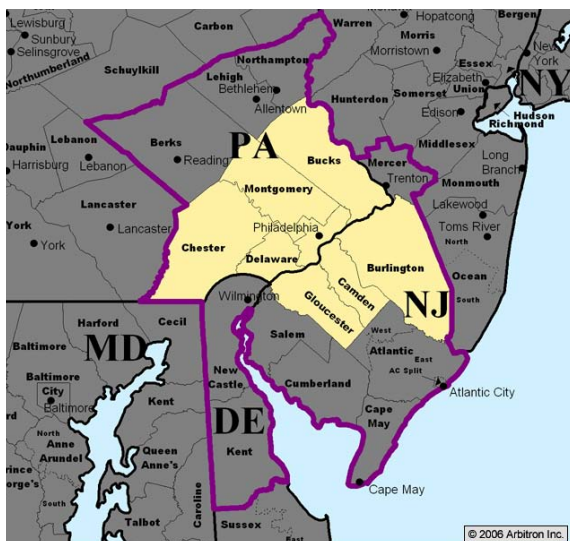
Arbitron's RADAR® and Nationwide services began to incorporate PPM™ respondents at the end of the 2007 survey year. As the Top 49 radio markets convert to PPM service, PPM respondents from those markets will roll into Arbitron's National Radio Services. RADAR and Nationwide estimates for all other markets will continue to be based on Diary respondents.

How the Data Are Combined

RADAR and Nationwide reports will include both the PPM and Diary methodologies in DMA®s that contain a PPM Metro. PPM measurement will supply the audience estimates for the Metro, and audience estimates for the non-Metro portion of the DMA will be provided by Diary measurement. Each report will include combined PPM and Diary estimates.

National Services Remain Unchanged

The inclusion of the PPM data will not change your RADAR and Nationwide services. You will receive the same estimates, and the data will run through the same software. The PPM and Diary markets will use the same 12 survey weeks, corresponding to the local market survey periods. RADAR and Nationwide estimates will continue to be based on Persons 12+.

A few differences in how the PPM data and the Diary data are reported, however, will necessitate the following minor adjustments:

- RADAR listening locations will change to "at home" or "out of home."
- In Nationwide DMAs that contain PPM Metros, estimates for stations that do not encode for the PPM service will be based only upon diaries and will be flagged.

Delivery of Combined Data

The PPM service was first commercialized in Philadelphia and Houston-Galveston, and the first RADAR and Nationwide reports with combined Diary and PPM data were delivered for these markets. Combined PPM and Diary data will follow for the remaining PPM markets as the PPM service is commercialized in each market. A detailed schedule follows.
